What has happened since our last newsletter?



The CLAIM partnership organised the **Final Conference and 5th Transnational Project Meeting**, which took place on **Tuesday, 16th December 2025**, at the **University of Naples Federico II**, C.E.S.T.E.V. – University Service Centre for Life Sciences and Technologies.

This final event represented a crucial milestone for the project, providing the opportunity to present the CLAIM results, share the outcomes of piloting activities in partner countries, and reflect on the impact of Artificial Intelligence for competences development and learning in VET and SME contexts.

Highlights of the Final Conference

The Final Conference opened with a welcome from the lead partner, followed by a keynote session dedicated to the **importance of adopting AI and technological solutions in education and human resource management in SMEs**.

A central part of the event was devoted to the presentation of the **CLAIM project and its main results**, including:

- the **CLAIM Model**, with its mapping of EU frameworks and soft skills educational resources;
- the **CLAIM digital platform**, supporting self- and hetero-assessment of competences, skills matching with ESCO profiles, CV analysis, AI-based interviews and personalised learning recommendations;
- the **interactive learning modules and Open Educational Resources (OER)**;
- **narrative branching scenarios and reverse mentoring approaches**;
- the results of **testing and validation activities** carried out in all partner countries.

Dedicated sessions also showcased the **national piloting experiences** in Italy, Greece, Spain, Bulgaria, Slovenia and Poland, highlighting feedback from learners, trainers and organisations involved.



Looking Back, Moving Forward

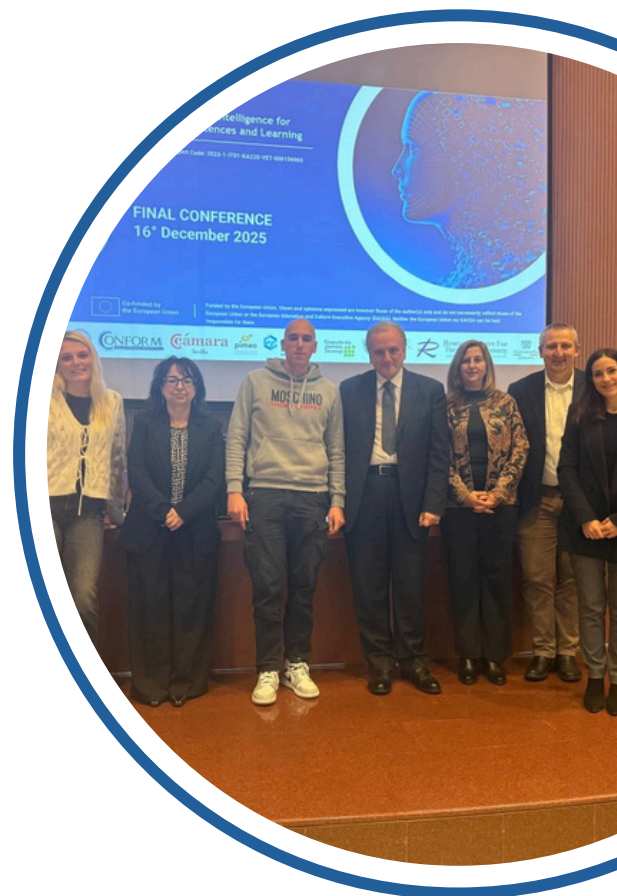


In the afternoon, project partners took part in the **5th Transnational Project Meeting**, focused on the pending administrative and dissemination activities.
